### **Frequently asked questions**

#### **Why was the fund set up?**

The Eileen Hewer Community Fund was established by the Lawley Village Management Committee in 2017, in remembrance of Eileen who sadly passed away in 2016.

Eileen was a Lawley Village resident who worked tirelessly to make sure residents' voices in Lawley were heard, through her role as Chair of Lawley Community Association and as a member of the Lawley Village Management Committee.

#### **Who can access the fund?**

The fund can only be applied for by Bournville Village Trust Lawley Village residents.

#### **What can the fund be used for?**

The fund can only be used for the benefit of Lawley Village residents and can be used to assist with;

- Not for profit, new or existing community groups and organisations
- Projects to enhance the environment
- Provision of community facilities

The fund cannot be used to fund individuals

#### **How much can be applied for?**

Funding of between £50-£2000 can be awarded.

#### **Who will make decisions about the fund?**

Lawley Village residents who attend the monthly Community Events and Activities Panel, with BVT officers and Resident Representatives.
